All three of these products are currently being evaluated, or are part of a Covid-19 vaccine or diagnostic test development.

In order to ensure that our pharmaceutical operations continue production during these uncertain times, our Special Products Suite is undertaking every necessary precaution to avoid a possible outbreak of Covid-19. These measures include, limiting essential personnel, avoiding close physical contact, and providing company transportation to and from employees' homes, among others.

And to ensure a continuity of Supply for Covid-19 related efforts, Desert King has decided to prioritize manufacturing, Quillaja raw material allocation, and personnel allotment to assist our Special Products manufacturing unit. Similarly, we have received clearance from the Chilean government to be designated as an essential business, to remain open during the pandemic crisis.
